

- **4.** ____ pouch. A pouch containing mail for Post Offices along a certain route
- 9. A roll of postage stamps
- 10. A postage stamp without separating holes
- **11.** Individual mailpieces aggregated into a unit such as a bundle, tray, or sack
- **12.** Segment of First-Class Mail containing payments typically enclosed in pre-barcoded automation-compatible courtesy reply envelopes
- 13. Pre-paid postage
- 14. PS Form 1510, Mail Loss/Rifling Report
- **15.** Stamp collecting that focuses on stamps, postage, covers, and other philatelic materials that relate to airmail
- **17.** The process of sending a package or piece of mail at a faster rate than normal

- **1.** A vibrating machine that aligns the edges of vertically stacked mailpieces
- 2. Plastic transparent window on envelope
- **3.** A mailpiece that cannot be sorted or delivered because of an incorrect, illegible, or insufficient delivery
- **5.** A postage-paid letter-size sheet of lightweight paper that was folded into an airmail envelope for correspondence to other countries
- **6.** Three adjoining stamps form a single design
- **7.** An addressing element used in Puerto Rican addresses that denotes an area, sector, or development within a geographic area
- **8.** The part of a stamp that displays the main design element such as a portrait
- 16. A third mail sorting operation

- **19.** A stamp condition in which the back of the stamp does not have hinge marks
- **20.** A marking intended to show a stamp has been used and is no longer valid
- **18.** A machine that applies paper or plastic to seal the ends of openended mailpieces
