4. __ pouch. A pouch containing mail for Post Offices along a certain route
5. A roll of postage stamps
6. A postage stamp without separating holes
7. Individual mailpieces aggregated into a unit such as a bundle, tray, or sack
8. Segment of First-Class Mail containing payments typically enclosed in pre-barcoded automation-compatible courtesy reply envelopes
9. Pre-paid postage
10. PS Form 1510, Mail Loss/Rifling Report
11. Stamp collecting that focuses on stamps, postage, covers, and other philatelic materials that relate to airmail
12. The process of sending a package or piece of mail at a faster rate than normal

1. A vibrating machine that aligns the edges of vertically stacked mailpieces
2. Plastic transparent window on envelope
3. A mailpiece that cannot be sorted or delivered because of an incorrect, illegible, or insufficient delivery
4. A postage-paid letter-size sheet of lightweight paper that was folded into an airmail envelope for correspondence to other countries
5. Three adjoining stamps form a single design
6. An addressing element used in Puerto Rican addresses that denotes an area, sector, or development within a geographic area
7. The part of a stamp that displays the main design element such as a portrait
8. A third mail sorting operation
9. A stamp condition in which the back of the stamp does not have hinge marks
10. A marking intended to show a stamp has been used and is no longer valid
11. A machine that applies paper or plastic to seal the ends of openended mailpieces
